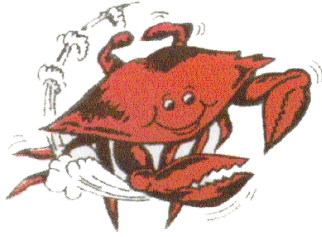

TOURNAMENT SERIES FINALS FORMAT:

QUALIFYING ROUND:

1. Each finalist will have the opportunity to bowl once in the Qualifying Round. This round will be a 5-game handicapped event, using the average rules and handicap system used throughout the Tournament Series.
2. The top 16 finishers in the Qualifying Round will return on Sunday, June 17, 2011 and participate in the head-to-head double elimination Championship Round.
3. Total pinfall plus handicap will determine the order of finish and placement in the Championship Round. Any ties will be broken by using the bowler's highest game(s) over average.

CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND:

1. Bowlers will participate in head-to-head matches as outlined below. For each game the bowler will receive a handicap of 80% of the difference of 160 and their average, disregarding fractions.
2. In case of a tie game, a two-frame roll-off (including appropriate handicaps) will determine the winner.
3. When a bowler loses two matches, that bowler is eliminated from Championship Round competition. The format is illustrated below:

FINAL MATCH: WINNER OF MATCH 23 VS. WINNER OF MATCH 29 (The Winner of Match 29 must win two games in order to win the Tournament Series Championship.)

**The losers of these matches are eliminated from the Tournament Series Championship.
